

## WAYS TO WORSHIP FOR THE MUSICALLY CHALLENGED SMALL GROUP

*Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship. Romans 12:1 (NIV)*

- **Read a Psalm**—and then spend time worshiping God for His care, faithfulness etc.
- **Share a victory**—tell your small group how God has worked in your life since the last time your group met and then worship the Lord for His help.
- **Choose and attribute**—take some time to meditate on one of Gods attributes, His holiness, omniscience, omnipresence, omnipotence etc. then as a group worship Him for these attributes.
- **Take communion**—communion is a time that Jesus calls us to remember Him. As you take communion as a group spend a few moments in worship of our Savior for all He has done.
- **Missions Moment**—what is God doing in other parts of the world? Worship Him as He brings people...from every tribe and language and people and nation...into His glorious kingdom.
- **Giving**—giving is an act of worship. Your small group can worship by choosing to contribute to charitable organization, a relief effort, sponsoring a child or taking up a collection to meet the needs of someone in the church, the community or the small group.
- **Read Revelation**—and join the in the worship of the Lamb that is taking place even now (see Revelation 4:11, 5:9-13, 7:9-12, 14:1-3, 15:3-4 and 19:1-8)
- **Celebrate change**—what were you able to apply in your life from the previous weeks lesson. Share it in the small group and then worship God as He works to bring about change in your life so that you better able to reflect the character of His Son.
- **Take a risk**—join hands and sing Jesus loves me together. Go ahead, make a joyful noise unto the Lord!
